Maryland Medicaid, VA-CCN, and most commercial medical insurances are accepted. The Harford County program also accepts Delaware Medicaid.

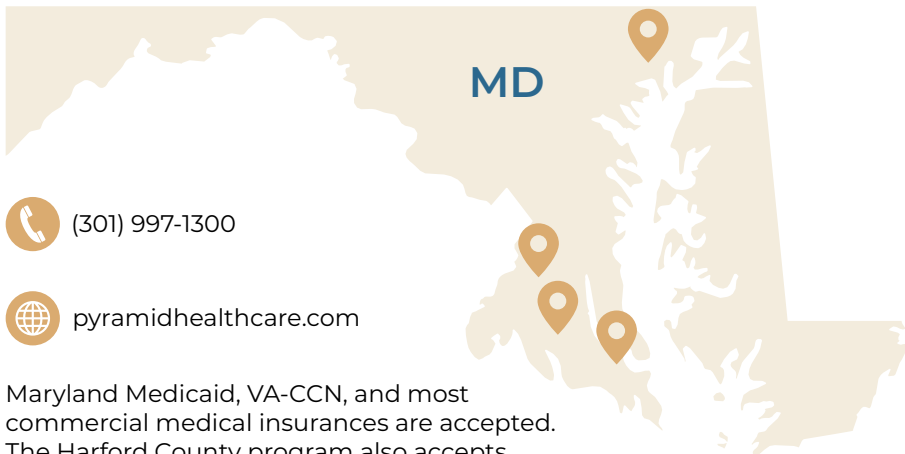
